How to apply?

To receive co-funding under the CEF Telecom calls, actions must demonstrate sufficient maturity, and contribute to EU Digital Single Market policies. The funding will be allocated to those eligible proposals which best meet the award criteria as specified in the 2019-2020 CEF Telecom Work Programme and in the relevant call texts. To guide the applicants through the application process, recording of the eID and eSignature presentation will be soon available on the Virtual Info Day website.

Applicants should submit their proposal through the dedicated proposal submission system, accessible from the individual call webpages on the 2020 CEF Telecom Calls web page. All call documents and additional background information are also available on the individual call webpages. Please remember that the deadline for this call is 20 May 2020 at 17:00.00 Brussels time.
