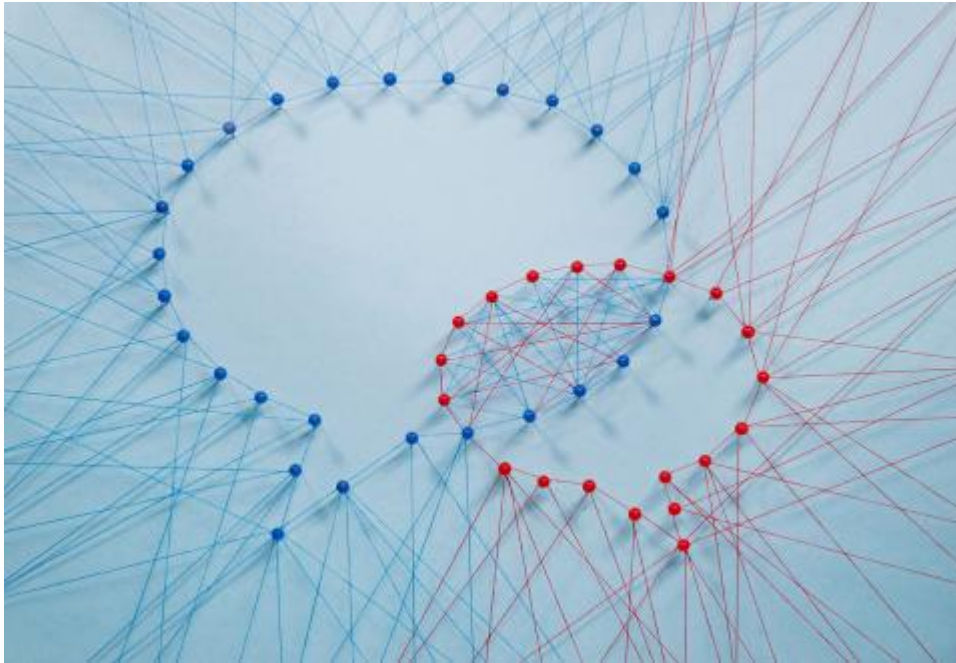


Web Accessibility Directive Expert Group (WADEX)
